## MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Currently, Springfield Golf and Country Club offers four types of memberships to new members – Active, Social, Corporate Sponsored Active Membership, and Corporate Associate Membership.

### ***Active Membership***

The Active membership provides access to all club facilities including golf, tennis, swimming and Clubhouse and dining facilities. These privileges are extended to the member's spouse and children under the age of 25. This category of membership has voting rights and the ability to hold office. Active membership is limited to 470 members. Once the level of 470 Active Members is reached, new applicants are placed on the Active wait list. This category permits limited golfing privileges and full use of all other facilities.

### ***Social Membership***

The Social membership includes use of the tennis, swimming, clubhouse and dining facilities. It also permits use of the golf practice facilities including the driving range and putting green, but not the golf course. These privileges are extended to the member's spouse and children under the age of 25.

### ***Corporate Sponsored Active Membership***

Springfield Golf and Country Club offers a unique opportunity for a business to provide a membership for one or more of its key employees or officers. The designated employee and their immediate family would enjoy unrestricted use of all of the club facilities. This includes the golf course, practice areas, clubhouse and dining, swimming pool and tennis courts. The Corporate Active Membership is transferable to another designee within the business entity with the payment of a transfer fee. The corporate designee must be approved for membership according to the club's by-laws.

### ***Corporate Associate Membership***

A business that has provided a Corporate Active Membership for one of its employees has an opportunity to provide a Corporate Associate Membership for up to three (3) other employees or officers. The Corporate Associate designee and their immediate family would have weekday access to the golf course and unrestricted access to the other amenities of the club. The corporate associate membership is also transferable to another designee within the entity with the payment of a replacement fee. The Corporate Active Membership must be in use for a Corporate Associate Membership to be available.



## **BECOMING A MEMBER AT SPRINGFIELD GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB**

- Contact our membership department at [membership@sgccva.org](mailto:membership@sgccva.org) and arrange to come in for a tour. Bring your family and come see all that Springfield Golf & Country Club has to offer. After you receive a tour our staff will answer any questions you have and provide you with all the information you need to apply for membership.
- Talk to some of our members. It is likely that you already know someone who is a member at Springfield Golf & Country Club. If so, we encourage you to talk to them and learn about their experiences at Springfield Golf & Country Club. If not, we will introduce you to some of our members for you to talk to. When you submit your application you will need a member to sponsor you.
- Submit an application for membership along with a check for \$1,000 as a good faith deposit. If your application is approved this amount will be applied toward your initiation fee.
- In addition to your application you will need to provide three written references. At least one of these should be from a Springfield Golf & Country Club member. Additionally, a credit check and background check are part of the application process.
- In accordance with our by laws, the name of applicants must be posted for at least 2 weeks prior to your application being approved. Your name will be posted once you submit your application.
- Once all references have been received, your name has been posted for the required time period, and the membership committee has had an opportunity to review your application, a committee member will contact you to schedule an interview. Interviews are conducted at the club and usually take about 1 hour.
- Once the membership committee approves your application, your application will be submitted to the Executive Committee for approval. The Executive Committee meets once per month on the last Tuesday of the month. You will be notified in writing of their decision.
- Once your application has been approved you will be asked to come in and meet with our accounting department to finalize your initiation fees. Several financing options are available for you to choose from, or you can opt to pay the fees up front. Once your fees are settled you will be provided your membership card and all the related information you need to begin using your membership.

On behalf of all of the members at Springfield Golf & Country Club I thank you for your interest in our club. Please take this opportunity to arrange for a tour of our facilities and seriously consider applying for membership. I know that you and your family will enjoy all that Springfield Golf & Country Club has to offer.



## GOLF COURSE



The Club's pride is a scenic 18-hole, par 71, 6,571-yard championship golf course. A total package of golfing activities includes competitions for men, women and juniors; an active couples program, a retiree's league and regular member/guest tournaments. The Club also offers a wide variety of programs for junior members, including tournaments, clinics and private lessons. A PGA professional and staff offer lessons and maintain a Pro Shop featuring the latest in golf equipment and merchandise.

Five sets of tees allow the golf course at Springfield Golf & Country Club to be enjoyed by every level of player.

Practice facilities include a driving range, putting green and a recently constructed chipping, pitching and bunker practice area.

Additional services offered by our pro-shop include: golf instruction from a staff of certified PGA professionals, clubs storage, club cleaning, club repair services, shoe care and spike replacement. Golf carts and pull carts are available for rental. Official USGA and VSGA handicaps are available to all golfing members and are required for club tournament-play. Marshals patrol the course to assist players and maintain an acceptable pace of play. The average 18 hole round of golf at Springfield Golf & Country Club takes 4 hours and 10 minutes.

The golf committee manages a full calendar of golf events throughout the year including monthly member/guest tournaments, an annual 3-day Member Guest event, 6 tournaments that comprise the "Springfield Cup" series, opening and closing breakfast tournaments and the club championship tournaments.



## TENNIS & FITNESS

Our current tennis facilities include seven Deca-Turf courts (3 indoor, 4 outdoor) which are lighted for evening play as are our two outdoor clay courts. An air-conditioned, year-round, three-court tennis bubble highlights an active tennis program featuring competitions for men, women, mixed doubles and juniors.

In 2006 the membership approved the funding for a new indoor tennis complex which is anticipated to be completed in the fall of 2009,

and which will replace the current tennis bubble. The new facility (see artist rendering) will include 3 indoor tennis courts, a pro-shop, locker facilities, snack bar and member's room. Additionally, a 6,500 square-foot fitness center will be added for our membership to enjoy. We are all excited about these new facilities which will significantly enhance the tennis and fitness offerings available today.





## CLUBHOUSE

In 2001 construction was completed on a new clubhouse facility. The main level of the new clubhouse includes a Members' Grill and Formal Dining Room, each with a fireplace, and a separate bar and lounge area. A large patio overlooks the 18<sup>th</sup> green and is a perfect location for outdoor dining and cocktails during the summer months. A large sitting room, golf pro-shop and management office complete the main floor. The lower level offers easy access to the Men's and Women's locker room facilities as well as two private card rooms, shoe shine station, golf bag storage and the



administrative offices. The top floor includes the formal Grand Ballroom (with seating up to 250), which can be divided into 2 smaller function rooms. The Grand Ballroom also offers a large outdoor balcony with spectacular views of the golf course and outdoor seating for up to 70 people. In addition to the ballrooms, a boardroom with capacity for up to 25 people is also available. The use of the function rooms is available to members at no additional charge. Catering services are available and private functions are welcome.





## SOCIAL

Social life abounds at Springfield Golf and Country Club. Numerous events and activities are scheduled for members throughout the year including dinners, special entertainment events, banquets and outings. Frequently, adult events are paired with a separate children's event so parents can enjoy themselves while the children are busy in another part of the clubhouse. ## POOL



The Club's swimming facility is centered on a six-lane 25-meter Z-shaped pool with a one-meter diving board and a separate toddler pool. The pool house has a full service food and beverage facility and a covered eating area. Our junior swim team The Sea Lions compete during June and July. Water aerobics classes and swim lessons are regularly available.

As part of the new tennis and fitness facility, the club membership also voted to construct a new pool house, renovate the existing pool and build a new toddler pool. The new facility will include men's and women's locker rooms, bathroom facilities and a snack bar. The new pool facility is scheduled to open in the spring of 2009.
